Metal Rods, Coils, Shelves	Recorded multiple takes of muted and unmuted hits (which were pitched high and low). Also used the coil piece and scratched the metal shelf. Dropped a bunch of rods together. Lightly hit the coil piece against the shelf to create a cymbal-like sound. Used metal rods on the guitar to create a slide effect. Used the rods on the autoharp to create a picking effect.	These rods, coils and shelves were from a shelving unit we had purchased for my brother's shower. It didn't end up working so we were going to pack it up to return, but before shipping it off I recorded 237 sounds.
